Intern Job Title: Teaching Assistant

Time Commitment: February - May 2018

Connectopod Learning teaches reading, writing, STEM, empathy and journalism using podcast as a vehicle. We work with students at schools and youth programs throughout the greater Los Angeles Area.

We are seeking Teaching Assistant interns to work with us as part of a collaboration with an elementary school in Granada Hills, CA. This commitment will be from February to May, 2018. It will require a commitment of 5 hours per week, with 2 of those hours teaching in a classroom of 1st grade - 3rd grade students. Staff will provide training and support.

Prior teaching experience is not needed. Experience with youth is a plus. Experience in acting or theater also a plus. Experience in journalism or media a plus, but not required. *Intern must be a current university or community college student.*

Intern Duties:

- Attend weekly trainings for Connectopod Curriculum prior to teaching in the classroom. Trainings will take place in Reseda or Northridge.
- Assist staff in teaching Connectopod Curriculum to an elementary school classroom (grades 1 - 3) twice a week for an hour each week (2 classroom teaching hours per week for 5 weeks). Teaching takes place in Granada Hills.
- Work with staff to enhance or modify activities and lessons based on students' needs.
- Lead classroom activities.
- Support students in brainstorm and writing.
- Give weekly feedback on student progress and contribute to end of project report.
